

Benefits

Contract teachers have extended health benefits through the School District. TTOCs have the opportunity to enrol in the Extended Health plan for TTOCs. This plan is through Pacific Blue Cross (Policy number 79626).

In order to enrol in the plan, you will need to complete the Application and Pre-Authorized Payment form. Completed forms are to be submitted to the School Board office payroll department. You are responsible for paying the premiums directly to PBC. TTOCs may apply for coverage up to 90 days from the date they become eligible.

What does the CTA do?

The CTA supports teachers in a variety of ways:

- Ensures the School District carries out its responsibilities according to our [Collective Agreement](#)
- Provides info on [leaves](#)
- Supports teachers through conflicts with other teachers, parents, or administration
- Processes [grievances](#) on behalf of teachers
- Answers questions and hears concerns from teachers regarding a wide variety of issues
